Pastor's Note on church opening

As you know we are starting back with the church service only, beginning at 10:45 AM. Complying with the State and Conference guidelines will be challenging, but with God's help it will work. To ensure safety of us all, we will be doing the following:

- There will be an ongoing sanitation of high-touch areas. - Hand sanitizer will be provided.
- We will need to situate our seating so that there is at least a six-foot distance between family units. Consequently, we cannot greet one another with a hand shake or hug at this time 😞
- There should be adequate ventilation in the sanctuary (if the weather is cool, dress accordingly)
- We will not be having children's classes or fellowship meals for a couple of weeks.
- For tithes and offerings, we will be using the offering box in the back of the sanctuary.
- A face mask may be beneficial, but not required. Feel free to bring and use as needed.
- And to comply, we must encourage our elderly, and those of us with underlying conditions due to age or illness, to continue isolation at home until state restrictions are eased. Those who attend do so at their own risk.
- And lastly, if you feel the slightest bit ill, **please remain home!**
